## **GENERAL BUSINESS:**

1. Locks to be changed by 9.00pm 4/9/07.
2. Mike Flannery spoke on the Xmas Function. It has been booked for 23/11/07 at South Toowoomba Bowls Club from 5.00pm.  
BBQ approx 6 – 6.30pm.  
Bowl to 9.00pm when lights go out.  
Cost: \$12.50/head which includes BBQ & Bowling. Last year the Club subsidised \$1600. There were no dissenting views and the general consensus was good.  
Mike moved that the Xmas Party be at the Bowls Club. Seconded by Kathi Thornton. Carried.
3. Mike called for numbers. Members are to send an email indicating numbers. A show of hands suggested the booking be for approximately 60 people.

Kathi Thornton suggested Club pay for 60 people @ \$12.50 = \$750.00 plus money on the bar. Other members thought it would be better if everyone paid for themselves to save funds for capital expenditure.

It was moved by Rob McDonald that the Club put \$1,000 on the bar. This was seconded by Brian Hensell. Carried.

4. President was asked by a non-active member if he would be charged full price again if the dam fills i.e: Do we just charge the uplift. General consensus was full fee.  
Craig Clancy moved that in-active members who want to upgrade to full membership have to pay full membership fees in addition to the inactive membership fee.  
Seconded by Marie Bartlett. Carried.
5. Cut Trees – Craig Clancy offered to discuss with Council the removal of bundled cut trees.
6. Main points of Club Rules read out by Murray Crawford. Sue Schluter to post them on website.
7. Craig Clancy has priced car park sealing:  
\$40,000 to do carpark;  
\$15,000 to do road.

(Richard McGorm suggested we could get a gaming grant for it)
  - b) possible alternatives.
